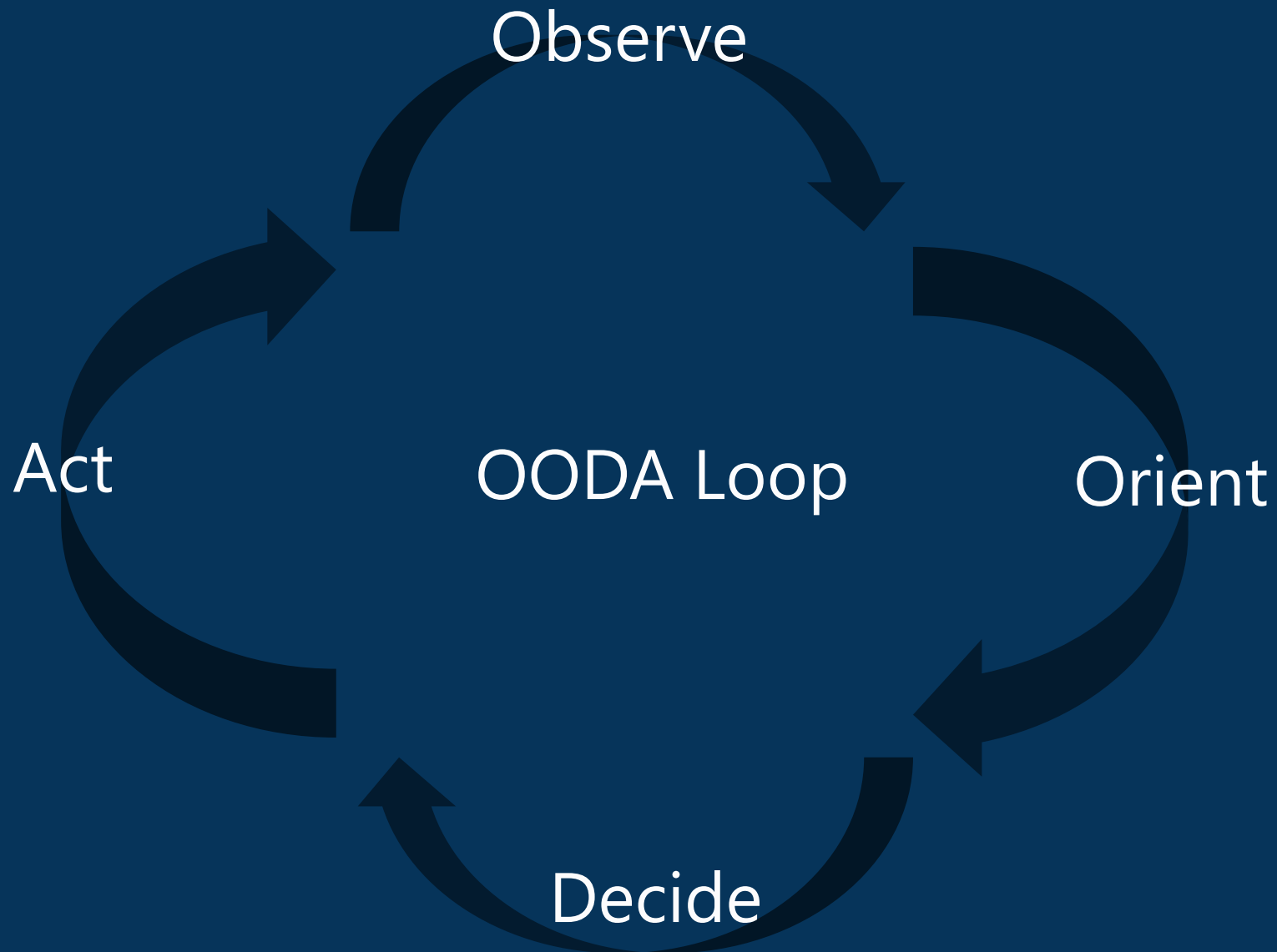

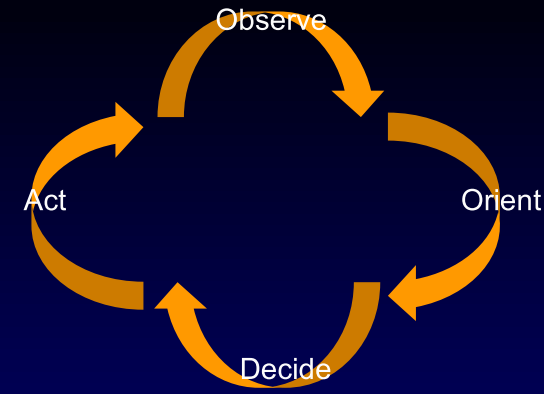

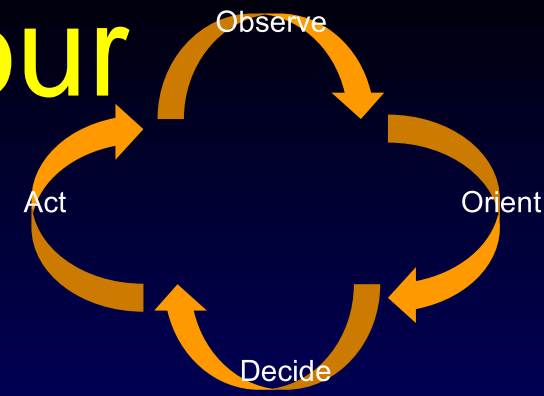


# Two Basic Discoveries

# Rabbinical Precision


- The Camp of Judah: **East** of Levites

A diagram of the Tabernacle showing the golden table, golden altar, and golden lampstand.

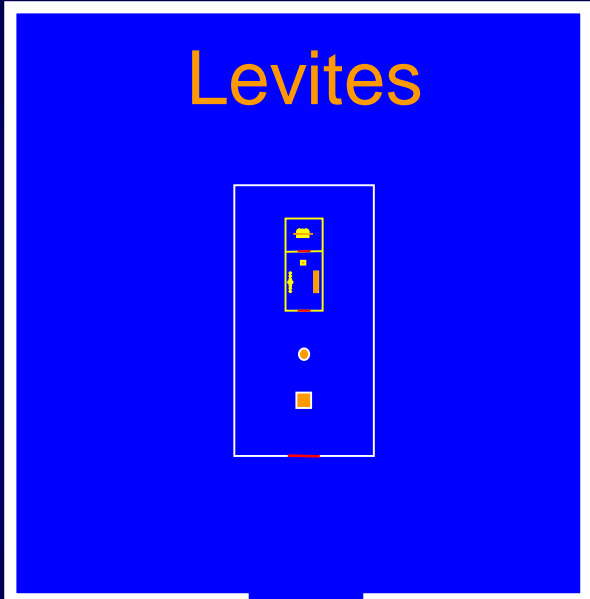
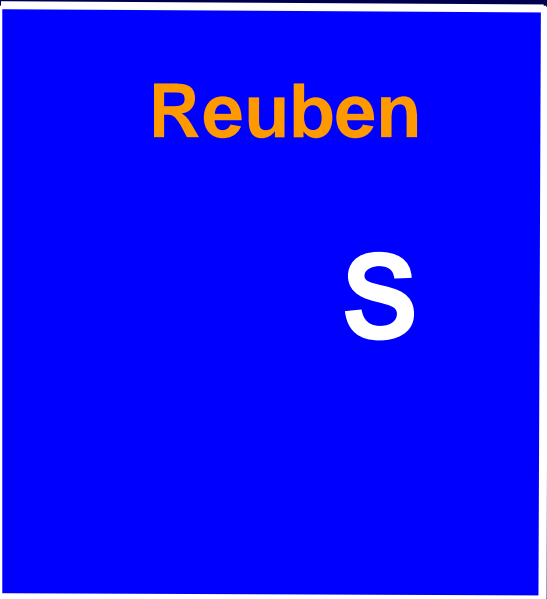

# Tribes of Israel

- Prior to the Egyptian captivity, the twelve tribes were simply the “sons of Israel” (genealogies reckoned in 1 Chronicles 2):
- Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, Dan, Naphtali, Asher, Gad, Joseph, Benjamin.
- Before Israel (the man) dies, he blesses Ephraim and Manasseh (the two sons of Joseph) and declares them to be considered fully sons of Israel for all purposes, including individual inheritance of land (Gen 48:5-6). So at the time of the Exodus, there were 13 tribes:
- Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, Dan, Naphtali, Asher, Gad, Benjamin, Manasseh, Ephraim.
- After the Exodus, Levi is set aside as the tribe devoted to God for the purposes of the functions of priesthood and Moses is told not to list them nor count them among Israel (Numbers 1:49). The tribes are now twelve again:
- Reuben, Simeon, Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, Dan, Naphtali, Asher, Gad, Benjamin, Manasseh, Ephraim.

**This composition is how the twelve tribes were counted for the rest of Israel’s history through the diaspora for the most part.**

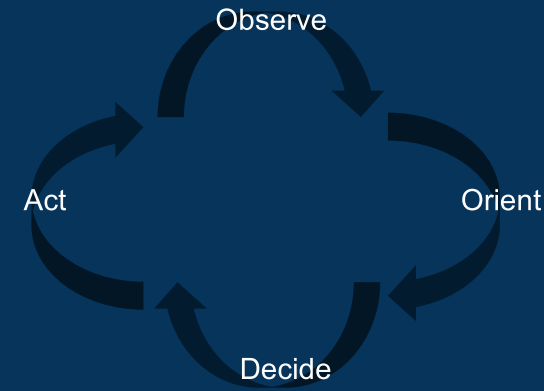
# Tribes and Apostles in Prophecy

- Ezekiel's vision of a future temple (Ezekiel 47 and on) includes land grant designations by tribe which follows the same tribe composition as above.
  - However, the same vision includes twelve gates (three on each side) that follows the “sons of Israel” designation where Levi is included as a tribe and Manasseh and Ephraim are subsumed into Joseph.
- The Book of Revelation adds to the mystery by having an entirely different composition when it refers to 12,000 from each of these tribes:
  - Judah, Reuben, Gad, Asher, Naphtali, Manasseh, Simeon, Levi, Issachar, Zebulun, Joseph, Benjamin.
  - This accounting includes Levi and gives Manasseh (but not Ephraim) individual designation separate from Joseph.
  - Most importantly, Dan is completely missing.
  - At the time of Solomon, Dan is one of two places where Jeroboam put the idols he used to prevent the people of his ten tribes from going to Jerusalem for required yearly duties before the temple and priests.

# 12...

- Significant parallels between the twelve tribes of Israel and the twelve Apostles of the Lamb.
  - Initially, twelve apostles are chosen, and Judas Iscariot is among them.
  - Judas betrays Jesus and hangs himself in the Potter's field (remember Jeremiah, Isaiah, and Zechariah's prophecies about the clay being marred in the Potter's hands).
  - Recall Dan and Idolatry being left out
  - That leaves eleven.
  - A twelfth is chosen by lot (Matthias) and Acts 1:26 records him as being "numbered with the eleven apostles."
  - The verse says he was numbered with them – it's perhaps another question whether Matthias was genuinely an apostle.
  - Saul of Tarsus becomes an apostle (he is never explicitly called an apostle except in his own letters).
  - That's thirteen, But like the OT and 12 tribes Revelation only recognizes twelve "Apostles of the Lamb":
- Rev 21:14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

# Significance of the Feasts



- *Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ. Colossians 2:16, 17*
- Each "feast" has a historic, memorial context (not to be a basis of criticism).
- Each "feast" is also prophetic!
- "The Jew's catechism is his calendar." Rabbi Samson Raphael Hirsch

# Spring Feast Details

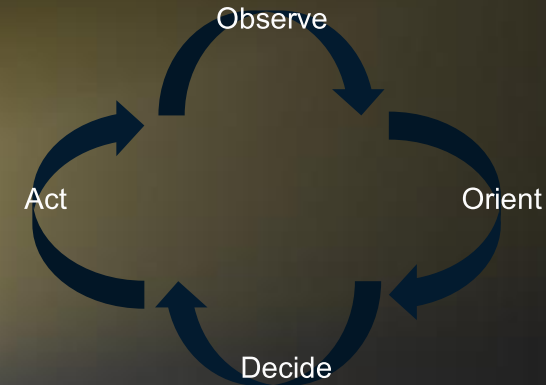
1. **Passover** occurs in the first month of the religious calendar, (Aviv, also called Nisan), on the fourteenth day, Leviticus (Vayikra) 23:5.
2. **Unleavened Bread** immediately follows the first day of Passover. It is observed in the first month (Aviv/Nisan) from the fifteenth day to the twenty-first day (Leviticus [Vayikra] 23:6 -8).
3. **Feast of First Fruits** of the barley harvest (Bikkurim) is observed during the week of Unleavened Bread. Anciently, on this day, sheaves of barley were waved before the L--rd in a prescribed ceremony. Today, this festival is not observed in traditional Judaism

# Passover Preview

- Passover: 14th of Nisan Passover is so essential for the Christian.
- Tidbit... Events at Passover leading to Christ's crucifixion were longer than a "Sabbath day's journey" permitted
  - Therefore, the 14th could not be on a Friday (erev, evening + boker, morning = day)
  - Each Hebrew "day" spans two days on our Roman based calendar...

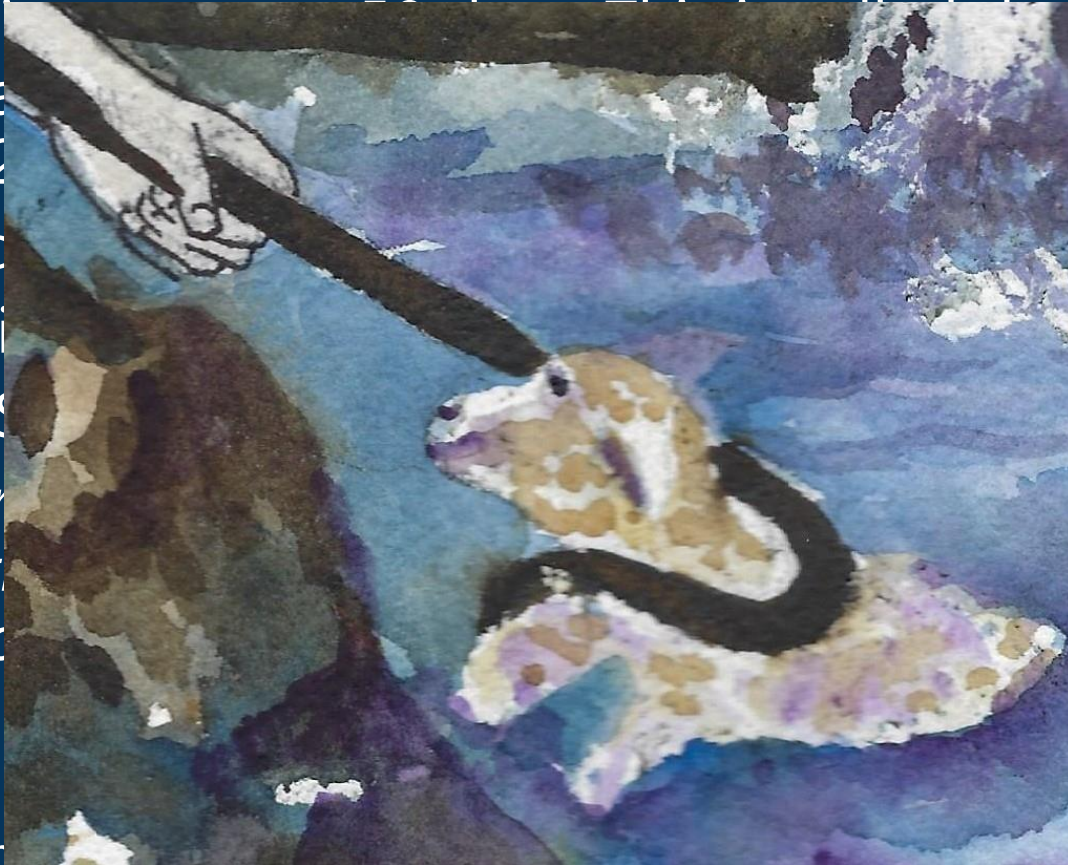

# The One in the Middle

- The Feast of Weeks (Shavuot) is also known as Pentecost. Beginning on the Feast of First Fruits, it is a period of seven weeks, ending with the counting of the omer. On the fiftieth day after the Feast of First Fruits, the Feast of Pentecost (Leviticus 23:15-16) is celebrated. (Note: Pentecost is the Greek word for "fiftieth.")
- Between the Spring and Summer Feasts, the Feast of Weeks (Shavuot) is celebrated.
- *And ye shall count the weeks, beginning from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the first fruits: even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the first fruits: the sabbaths shall be complete: ye shall count the number fifty days; Leviticus 23:15,16*
  - "Counting the Omer"
  - One of three compulsory (Leviticus 23:15-17).
  - Only use of Leavened Bread! Two loaves (Jew & Gentile?)
- Prophetic: The Birth of the Church—Feast of Pentecost (Acts 2)



**Does the Jewish 'Clock' of Daniel's 70 weeks of years stop at Pentecost?**



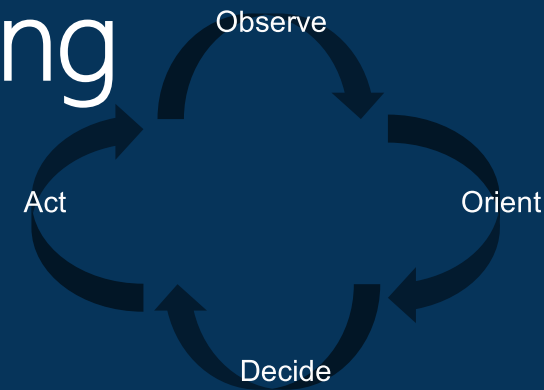

# The Fall Feasts *Anticipate* the Second Coming

- The fall festival season begins
    - With a 40-day period called, in Hebrew, Teshuvah , which means "to repent or return."
    - This 40-day period begins in the sixth month of the religious calendar, the month of Elul, and concludes on the tenth day of the seventh month
  - Feast of Trumpets ( Rosh Hashanah )
    - Tishrei 1 and 2; a single day
    - Tishrei 3 through Tishrei 9 – days of silence... No Trumpet blasts – are called the Days of Awe or the Awesome Days – Seven Days... Week of years in Tribulation?
  - Yom Kippur - The day of Atonement
  - Sukkot - The Feast of Tabernacles
- After this Cycle... Simchat Torah - Rejoicing in the Torah

# The Mystery of Enoch

- Jude 1: 14-15 *Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."*
- Oldest prophecy uttered by a prophet and it is about the 2nd Coming of Christ!
- Three groups of people facing the judgment of the Flood:
  - 1) those that perished in the flood;
  - 2) those that were preserved through the time of the flood; and,
  - 3) those that were removed prior to the flood.
- Was Enoch born on Shavout?
- Was Enoch removed prior to the judgment on his birthday?
  - The Church was "born" on Shavout (Acts 2).
  - Will the Church be removed on its birthday?

***Will the Jewish "clock" restart on the same feast day that it was stopped?***

# Caveats

- We should embrace the treasure of our heritage, and the patterns that teach us...
- However, beware the lure of legalism (The Council in Jerusalem; Acts 15).
- Abraham was saved before he was circumcised, and before the Law was given...

# Jasher – Jubilees – 1 Enoch

- Not in the Biblical Canon as we know it but are Biblically endorsed
- Follow the same chronological order as Genesis
- Mentioned / Quoted in the inspired word of God
- Where are these three books mentioned?
- Jasher
  - Joshua 10: 13
  - 2 Sam 1: 18
- Jubilees
  - 2 Tim 3: 8
  - Jannes and Jambres
  - Pharoah's priests not mentioned in Exodus – Mentioned only in Jubilees
- 1 Enoch – Jude 1: 14

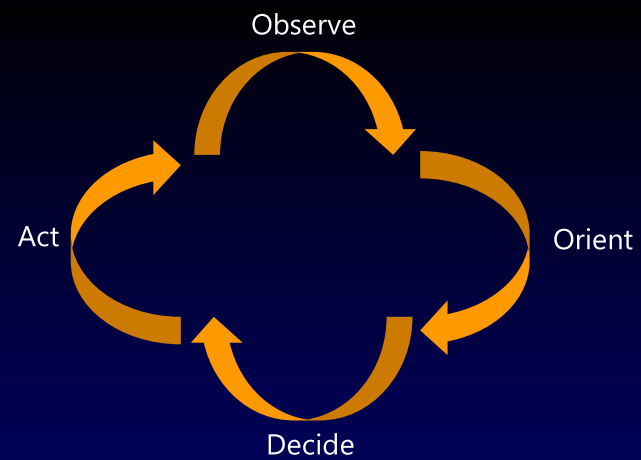

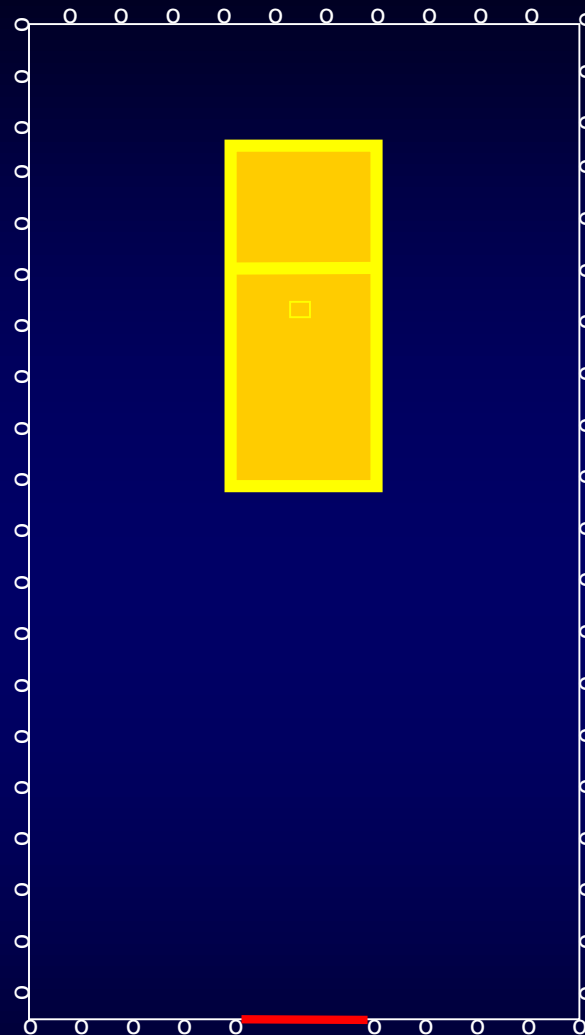
# Things to Come

- Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man. Heb 8: 1-2
- For a tabernacle was prepared: the first part, in which was the lampstand, the table, and the showbread, which is called the sanctuary; and behind the second veil, the part of the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of All, which had the golden censer and the ark of the covenant overlaid on all sides with gold, in which were the golden pot that had the manna, Aaron's rod that budded, and the tablets of the covenant; Heb 9: 2-5
- But into the second part the high priest went alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and for the people's sins committed in ignorance; the Holy Spirit indicating this, that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing. It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience—concerned only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time of reformation. Heb 9: 7 – 11
- And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1: 14

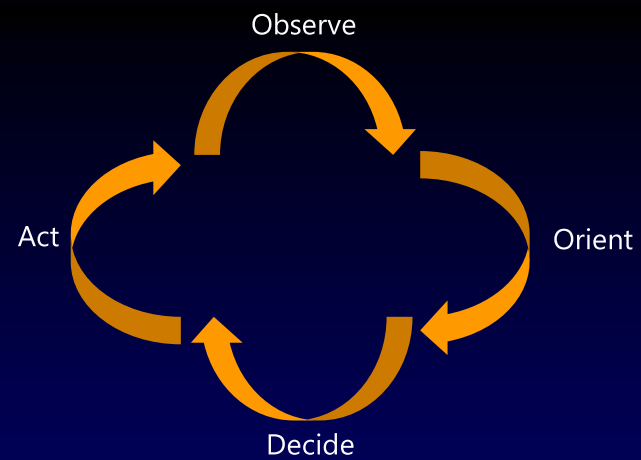

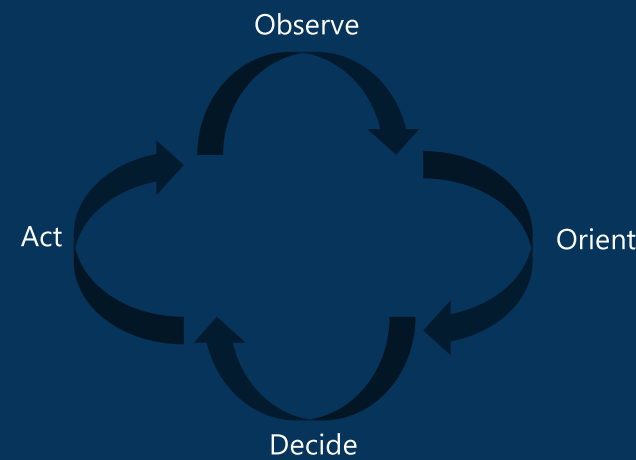

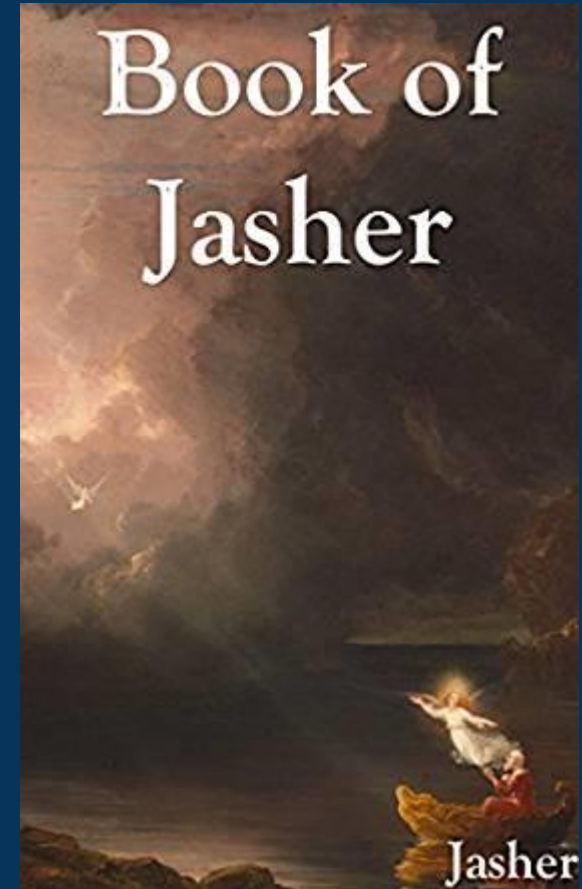
# 1 Enoch

- Author: Enoch – walked with God then was not
- Ministry is to pre-flood people
- Reads like a Blockbuster Movie
- Tremendous detail of Fallen ones' war against the Creator
- Out of this world encounters with Angels, demons, and the supernatural
- Corruption that led to the Flood
- Viewed by some as Scripture – But not in today's normal cannon
- While some dispute whether 1 Enoch should be scripture, what cannot be denied is the influence the book had on the writers of scripture.
- Could it be that 1 Enoch was preserved for us? For such a time as this?

# Jasher

- Jasher reads more like a 'Chick-Flick'
- Much longer book – More people stories
- Focuses on the relationships of the characters we read about in the Torah
  - Bruce Catton's book, *Grant Moves East*
- Fills in a lot of 'People' gaps
- Details why Enoch did not die
- Amazing details of the corruption of all flesh and why YHWH flooded the earth.
- Who is Amraphel of Gen 14? (Nimrud)
- Who is Melchizedek? (Possibly Shem)





# Jubilees

- The 'little' Genesis
- The Apocalypse of Moses
- Paul mentions people by name who are not in Torah--- But names are in Jasher
  - Priests who challenged Moses and Aaron before Pharaoh
